2019 NATION OF PATRIOTS TOUR

Saddle up riders, the 10th annual Nation of Patriots Tour is coming to Slidell. The Nation of PatriotsTM is a 501(C)3 nonprofit organization created to promote awareness of the financial, physical, emotional, and economic misfortune that our wounded veterans and their families are living with today and every day.

They work to unite Americans around the Stars and Stripes to stand behind the men and women who have served or are serving in the United States Armed Forces. They raise money through their national network and distribute 100% of all donations received directly to the veterans they strive to help. They work with VA facilities and many other veteran organizations to help locate and select the veteran families based on established criteria.

The tour begins the weekend before Memorial Day in Beaver Dam, WI (this year it began on 18 May) and tours a single American Flag through the 48 contiguous United States over the course of 110 days and over 14,000 miles. The flag returns to Beaver Dam, WI on the weekend following Labor Day where it will rest until next year's tour. This year the flag will arrive at Northshore Harley Davison, Slidell, LA from Baton Rouge at approximately 11:30 am, Saturday, 27 July. A "Passing The Flag" ceremony will be conducted at 12:30 pm featuring the Northshore High School ROTC Honor Guard and Rifle Team. Following the ceremony, lunch will be served by provided, courtesy of Northshore Harley-Davidson. The flag will remain at the dealership until it is scheduled to depart at 11:00 am, Sunday, 28 July in route to the U.S. Coast Guard Station in Gulfport, MS. The Northshore Harley Davidson flag bearer, chosen in a random drawing, will be Richard Dillon, a retired U.S. Army Veteran.

Because we anticipate a large number of riders will be participating in the escort mission from Slidell to Gulfport, we will begin lining up bikes in the dealership parking lot at 9:45 am, 28 July. So plan to arrive early. If you have questions about the ride, contact ride coordinators Perry and Karen Otillio (985-630-6527). There will be a police escort to the Mississippi state line where the Mississippi State Police will provide an escort to the U. S. Coast Guard Station in Gulfport. The ceremony in Gulfport will include lunch. We would like to provide an estimate of how many riders and passengers will be participating, so if you are planning to ride to Gulfport and stay for lunch, please contact Joy Mehrtens via email at: joymehrtens@aol.com.

Rider's Checklist

A-Attitude. How do I feel about this trip? Am I fully focused on the ride?

M-Medication. Am I taking anything that will affect my performance?

I-Illness. Do I have any unresolved illnesses or allergies?

S-Sleep. Am I fatigued; did I get enough rest?

A-Alcohol. If I drink alcohol, I can't ride safely.

F-Food. Am I hungry, dehydrated, or do I have low blood sugar?

E-Emotions. Am I angry, depressed, or stressed? Will I take risks?
