SAFETY BREAK

Okay, I won't go as far as saying it is getting cold out there, but the days are typically getting shorter and cooler this time of year. This month just some cautions about your motorcycle rides in cold weather.

It's not a bad idea to let the bike warm up a little, especially if you keep it in an unheated garage; and make sure to roll it out the door before you let it run. We don't want any CO2 issues!!

Once you are on those backroads we all love to ride, please be extra careful. Overnight temperatures are getting cooler and can cause slick spots on some roads in early morning hours; and remember bridge surfaces tend to freeze before road pavement.

Also, a few trees typically shed their leaves this time of year and wet leaves can be treacherous on a curve; or even on a straightaway.
